





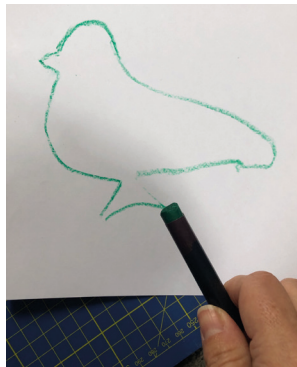
Zoom Journey Worksheet

Making your shadow puppet

This week we'll create characters, and turn them in to shadow puppets!

What you will need:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Paper, pencils, pens to draw your puppet
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collage material (pictures or paper torn or cut from old magazines) to make a puppet
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scissors, glue and tape.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cardboard - such as an old cereal packet. Sticks - twigs from the garden, and old lolly stick or a pencil will do!



Start by drawing your character, or creating one by cutting out magazine pictures.



Cut your character out



Stick on to card

Next, cut around your character, and stick on to your card using glue.



When glue is dry cut around your character with scissors



When the glue is dry, carefully cut around your character with scissors (If needed, you can ask someone who supports you to help)



Now you can attach your character to a stick using tape.



Your character is ready to be a shadow puppet!



You can practice moving your puppet by shining a torch against a wall to see the shadow.



You could create some more characters to be a part of your story!

You can also colour your puppet in if you would like!
